IV. <u>9:03 a.m. NRB Office and Budget Update</u>

The NRB continues working on the transition to the Land Use Review Board. Chair Haskell provided background information on the Land Use Review Board nominating committee, the NRB is not on the nominating committee. The application for Board seats is open until September 16, 2024. Information on the Land Use Review Board nominating committee can be found on the Legislature offices website and on the NRB website.

For information on interim exemptions passed in Act 181 of 2024, we have webpages with information on our website, including an interactive map that displays the different potential exemption areas. In addition to the map, we've created some guidance documents and will continue to update those as necessary.

NRB hired a District Technician for the Rutland office (District 1 & 8) Elaine McDevitt, she started yesterday. Additionally, District 6 has a new commissioner, Brendan Deso. Both will be in Essex for training today.

NRB received FY 2026 budget instructions and will begin budget planning in the next few weeks.

V. <u>9:09 a.m. Discussion of appeals, enforcement, and attorney-client memoranda.</u> Attorney Stone provided an update on two case settlements since the last board meeting. The NRB has a handful of appeals in front of the Supreme Court where the Attorney General's Office is representing the NRB.

The NRB participated in an enforcement action hearing earlier this week. The judge ruled from the bench deciding that the Assurance of Discontinuance the NRB issued was sufficient.
