All three CACC form were updated to include the “Master Plan Fee (if applicable)” field:

- Projects Deemed Complete from July 1, 2010 – July 1, 2015 (ver. 2.1 - rev. 6/24/20) (BLUE heading)
- Projects Deemed Complete from July 1, 2015 – November 1, 2019 (ver. 1.6 - rev. 6/28/20) (YELLOW heading)
- Projects Deemed Complete on or After November 1, 2019 (ver. 2.1 - rev. 6/25/20) (GREEN heading)

November 1, 2019

CACC Forms have been updated as follows:

- Three online PDF versions of the forms were created:
 - Projects Deemed Complete from July 1, 2010 – July 1, 2015 (ver. 2.0 - rev. 11/1/19) (BLUE heading)
 - Projects Deemed Complete from July 1, 2015 – November 1, 2019 (ver. 1.5 - rev. 8/20/19) (YELLOW heading)
 - Projects Deemed Complete on or After November 1, 2019 (ver. 2.0 - rev. 8/27/19) (GREEN heading)
- The pre-July 1, 2010, form is still available upon request and can be printed or emailed to an applicant.
- Previous versions of the 2010-2015 forms inaccurately assessed an amendment application minimum fee of \$150.00, when this base fee should have been assessed at \$50.00. The new 2010-2015 form corrects this error by adding a check box that states, “Please check this box if the Schedule A associated with this Certification of Actual Construction Costs was for an amendment application.” The minimum fee calculations in the form have been corrected accordingly.
- As of November 1, 2019, we no longer collect ANR fees for Administrative Amendments. The post-November 1, 2019 CACC reflects the change by adding the following checkbox:
 - “Please check this box if the Schedule A associated with this Certification of Actual Construction Costs was for an ADMINISTRATIVE amendment application.” When the Administrative Amendment check box is selected, the “ANR Fee” line calculation will automatically zero-out.
- The new versions of the forms also contained updated references to statutes online and updated footnotes to reflect fee changes from 2010 and 2015 fee bills
